Philippians 1:27-30

This morning, we see Paul's encouragement to the church to remember the main focus of the Christian life and his encouragement to maintain unity. They were in danger of overlooking it by being discouraged by their opponents and losing their zeal in the fight.

If you want to live a life worthy of the gospel ...

- **Remember that your Conduct matters. vs. 27a**
 - Your main purpose is to bring your life into conformity of the gospel.

- **Let us together remain Committed to Christ and to one another. vs. 27b**
 - may we stand firm for the gospel in unity!

- **May we remain Courageous and Confident together for the gospel. vs. 28**
 - may we strive side by side for the gospel
 - may we be fearless before the enemies of the gospel

- **May we consider that we have been Consecrated to Christ. vs. 29-30**
 - may we be unified as brothers and sisters in the gospel
