

## BBC Christmas Consignment for Missions

Participants may choose to consign their items, splitting the profit 50/50 with the mission project, or donate outright. Profits from donations will be credited 100% to the mission project. All types of items will be included, not just clothing and toys. If you have furniture, tools, small appliances, household goods, home décor, etc., feel free to include those if they are in great condition (stain/odor free with lots of life left). As always, any donations of new items are gladly accepted! We are asking for your help to ensure we have a high-quality event! If you are able, we would truly appreciate your willingness to tag all donations/consignments before drop-off (instructions below). This spreads out the work required to put on an event of this size. Consignors will have the opportunity to mark their items to be donated in case they do not sell, or they may pick up unsold items when the sale is over. At this time, we have no limit to the number of items that may be brought, but that could change if space becomes limited.

Never participated in a consignment sale? Here are a few helpful tips for how to organize:

- 1) Go through closets, drawers, storage buildings and set aside items you no longer need/use in excellent to gently-used condition. Do you have gift items that have never been opened/used?
- 2) Gather supplies: \*Index cards \*Safety pins \*Hangers (can be provided by the church while supplies last) \*Zip-top bags \*Masking tape \*Permanent markers
- 3) Make sure everything is washed/cleaned/stain-free; all sets are together (group smaller items to sell in sets); No missing parts, batteries, zippers, buttons, etc.
- 4) Group items and determine pricing. **\*\*Price items to sell** – remember our main goal is to serve our community and raise money for missions!\*\* Check out the pricing guide on [www.littleredhentagging.com](http://www.littleredhentagging.com) for great pricing tips. Place clothing on hangers; group small items in zip-top bags; group like items in bundles (books, jewelry, small toys, etc.)
- 5) Fill out and attach tags to all items. **\*Get started now!\***

*Now for a few rules/guidelines:*

Consignor numbers will be assigned – Aaren Frye will be handling these. You may request a number from her at [aarenfrye@gmail.com](mailto:aarenfrye@gmail.com). Donations will have a unique BBC code.

All prices are to be in even dollar increments...no change. Suggested max prices should be no more than 30-40% of original cost. Remember our mission!

Used clothing/Shoes/Bags - \*Must be in current style in great to excellent condition with no rips/tears/holes that aren't original to the manufacturer. \*No missing buttons or zippers. \*No stains, pet hair, or odors (all items are to be clean/washed and on hangers which can be provided while supplies last if necessary...smaller items may be placed in zip-top bags). \*Shoes must be attached in pairs and be well cleaned with plenty of wear left. \*NO undergarments unless they are new...pajamas may not be excessively worn and must have matching pieces.

Games/Toys/Outdoor Items: \*Must be clean (wipe them down thoroughly), contain all pieces/working parts (organized in clear storage bags if necessary – no loose pieces). \*Batteries are required, so if you need help with these, please let us know. \*Books and puzzles need to be in excellent condition. \*Tags may be taped or tied to larger toys/items.

Furniture/Appliances/Household goods and décor: \*Must be clean with no stains/odors and in great working condition (please test before you bring). \*If necessary, group like items together before pricing.

Makeup/Perfumes/Jewelry/etc.: \*Smaller items must be bundled together in small packages and tagged.

Sale Date/Time: Saturday, December 10, 2022; 8:00am-2:00pm      *Consignors willing to work a 2-hour shift during drop-off, pick-up, or sale time will be given the opportunity to shop early on Friday, December 9<sup>th</sup> from 5:30-8:00.*

Drop-Off Dates/Times: These dates/times have not been settled on at this time but tentatively include one day during the week of November 20<sup>th</sup>, one day during the week of November 27<sup>th</sup>, and two days during the week of December 4<sup>th</sup>.

Pick-Up Date/Time: Monday, December 12<sup>th</sup> from 5:00-8:00. \*Please note that if items are not picked up at this time (without prior notification of reason), they will be set aside for donation.
